- o be neatly drawn with sharp outlines
- use saturated colors if coloring
- be adoptable to different scales and different uses (i.e. on posters, projected image, hard copy ...)
- be inspiring, smart and memorable
- be relevant to themes of education, space exploration, technology or communication as they relate to the ARISS program (to learn more about ARISS, visit the following webpage, <u>http://www.ariss.org/</u>).
