



Preparing for (MS)²TC and NASA/ARISS Radio Contact with the International Space Station Event

ENGLISH Homework assignment due FRIDAY, JANUARY 24th

When we have our radio contact with ISS astronauts in March, we need to be prepared with some relevant, well-thought-out questions. To that end we are having a competition, entry into which is mandatory for all (MS)²TC students.

Your entry will consist of one question suggestion and must include the following elements:

1. The question must be based on research you have conducted on, or knowledge that you have of, the ISS (International Space Station). Questions should exhibit genuine interest and curiosity.
2. You must write 1-2 paragraphs to provide an explanation and justification on the relevance/importance of your question (Hint: use the skills you learned in writing persuasively to help your case).

From the entries received the (MS)²TC faculty will choose 5 questions which will be used on the day of contact.
